## Boaters Safety Course

### IT'S THE LAW...

Persons born after December 31, 1978 and 12 years of age and older shall not operate a personal watercraft until they obtain and carry a Boating Safety Certificate. All other operators are strongly encouraged to enlighten their knowledge of any laws pertaining to boats and personal watercrafts by registering for this course.

- **Dates: Friday, May 8 & May 15, 2009**
- Time: 6:00pm-9:00pm
- Location: Greenville Community Center, 900 E. Kent Rd., Greenville
- Cost: FREE
- Who: Any age; children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Pre-register by 5:00pm, May 4, 2009.

### INFORMATION

- It is mandatory you attend both classes and successfully complete the course and written test to be issued the Michigan Boaters Safety Certificate.
- A Montcalm County Sheriff's Office Marine Officer will instruct the course.
- **Online Boaters Safety Course Offered:** After completing the online portion of the Michigan Boater Safety program, the certification exam must be administered in person by a authorized Boaters Safety Instructor. Those interested in completing the exam portion of the class only may do so. Exam will be conducted on May 15th at 7:30pm.
