Old Business:

Review 2009 Weed Control Program

Tony reported that three treatments were done on the lake last year. Milfoil, pondweed, and algae were the dominant plants.

Update on 2010 Weed Control Program

A survey was done on May 18. Large amount of milfoil was found. Norm treated on May 15. Tom reported that the treatment seems to be working good. There is still milfoil, but it seems to be dying off and looks like the growth has been stopped. Tony thinks spot treatment may still be needed this year and maybe an algae treatment. A sonar treatment may be warranted in either 2011 or 2012. The lake fund has enough funds to cover the sonar treatment.

New Business

Tom reported that there is no new action taken on the new pier. The county received a grant to put in a new ADA fishing pier, but property owners are not in favor of it. The township zoning did not approve the plan.

The board would like to have future public notices published in the River Valley Shopper as well as the Daily New. The River Valley has better circulation in the area than the Daily News.

There being no further business to come before the Lake Board, a motion was made by Tom and seconded by Richard to adjourn the meeting at 4:25 P.M.
