**EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES**  
**RESCUE TEAM LEADER**

**Irregular, Part-Time**

**Education:** High school graduation or equivalent preferred. Must have successfully completed at least a Medical First Responder program.

**Experience:** A minimum of one (1) year experience in Emergency Medical Services, with at least six-(6) month's experience as a Rescue Attendant or equivalent.

**Other Requirements:**

1. Must possess and maintain a valid Michigan driver's license. Must have reliable transportation.
2. Must possess and maintain, as a minimum, licensure by the state's EMS Division as a Medical First Responder.
3. Must meet specific departmental and Medical Control Authority requirements including, but not limited to:
  - A. Annual Hazardous Materials First Responder Awareness training.
  - B. Annual departmental Exposure Control Program training.
  - C. Extrication training (if applicable).
  - D. Emergency driving training.
  - E. Tuberculosis testing valid within one (1) year.
  - F. Hepatitis vaccination or valid declination of same.
  - G. Annual recertification of medical skills commensurate with licensure.
  - H. Other training as prescribed on an annual basis in response to identified individual or system deficiencies.

*The qualifications listed above are intended to represent the minimum skills, requirements and experience levels associated with performing the duties and responsibilities contained in this job description. The qualifications should not be viewed as expressing absolute employment or promotional standards, but as general guidelines that should be considered along with other job related selection or promotional criteria.*

**Physical Requirements** *[This position requires the ability to perform the essential functions contained in this description. The following list of physical requirements represents minimum capabilities. Reasonable accommodations will be made for otherwise qualified applicants unable to fulfill one or more of these requirements]:*

Ability to pass physical agility and strength test prescribed or administered by the department.

Ability to carry injured person on cot, backboard and stretcher as part of a two-person team.

Ability to carry persons on cot, stretcher, backboard or stair chair up and down stairs and over rough terrain as part of a two-person team.

Ability to lift injured person from floor to cot, cot to bed, etc. as part of a two-person team.

Ability to lift and carry various pieces of emergency medical equipment weighing up to 70 pounds.

Ability to perform rescue operations in rough terrain and in hard to reach locations.

Ability to drive rescue and ambulance vehicles in all types of weather conditions and at all times of the day and night.

Ability to work in cramped body positions.

Squatting, stooping, kneeling, and reaching to perform rescue operations.

**Working Conditions:**

Works in any and all locations where persons may be sick or injured, including roads, buildings, fields, woods, etc. at various sites throughout the county, but primarily within a prescribed area within the county.
