## **Housing Commission Ordinance**

**Adopted: August 10, 1978**

ORDINANCE NO. 1-1978

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A HOUSING COMMISSION WITHIN  
THE COUNTY OF MONTCALM, MICHIGAN

WHEREAS, housing conditions exist in Montcalm County, Michigan that are detrimental to the public peace, health, safety, morals and welfare of the citizens of the County; and

WHEREAS, there exists a shortage of adequate housing in the County for persons of low income; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that a housing commission be created in Montcalm County, Michigan to address the housing problem within the County;

NOW THEREFORE, the County of Montcalm ordains;

Section 1. Pursuant to Public Act No. 18 of the extra session of 1933, as amended, a housing commission is hereby created in and for the County of Montcalm, Michigan to be known as the "Montcalm County Housing Commission", and that said housing commission shall have the following enumerated powers and duties:

- a. To determine in what areas of the county it is necessary to provide proper sanitary housing facilities for families of low income and for the elimination of housing conditions which are detrimental to the public peace, health, safety, morals, and/or welfare;
- b. To purchase, lease, sell, exchange, transfer, assign and mortgage any property, real or personal, or any interest therein, or acquire the same by gift, bequest or under the power of eminent domain; to own, hold, clear and improve property; to engage in or to contract for the design and construction, reconstruction, alteration, improvement, extension, and/or repair of any housing project or projects or parts thereof; to lease and/or operate any housing project or projects;
