

**CRYSTAL TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING MINUTES**

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Braman at 7:01 p.m. and was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment: Tom Scott, Montcalm County Central Dispatch Director: He informed us that the August 3<sup>rd</sup> Primary Ballot will have a request for an increase to the 911 surcharge, from \$1.89 to \$3.00, for a period of 4 years. If this passes the funds will not be collected till July 2011.

Dick Harry presented the Township Board with \$1943.00 for the Bike/Walk Path. The funds were raised from the Golf Outing he organized.
