

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Montcalm County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing on September 14, 2009 at 1:30 p.m. The purpose of the hearing will be for the public to comment on the proposed budget for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010. **The property tax millage rate proposed to be levied to support the proposed budget will be a subject of this hearing.**

The proposed millage rates to be levied are 4.4082 mills for the County's general operations, .7000 mills for the maintenance and operation of an Ambulance and Rescue Service, .4407 mills for the purpose of providing funds for local libraries in Montcalm County, .2433 mills for the Commission on Aging for Senior Citizens Services, and .0200 mills for the purpose of funding the Soldiers and Sailors Relief Fund for a total millage request of 5.8122 mills. A budget total of \$25,777,998.42 is proposed for fiscal year 2010.

The hearing will be held in the Jack Van Harn Board of Commissioners Room, Third Floor of the Administrative Building, at 211 W. Main Street, Stanton, Michigan. The proposed budget may be examined Monday through Friday at the above address in the Office of the County Controller between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. beginning September 9, 2009.
